Bake Pure Co. LLC, a Colorado limited liability company based in Loveland, Colorado ("**Company**"), operates the website located at <https://bakepureco.com/> ("**Site**"). The Site provides general information about the Company's allergy-friendly cottage food bakery, lists ingredients for menu items, and offers a basic contact form for inquiries about catering or larger orders. No ecommerce or online checkout occurs on the Site; all sales occur offline at the Company's bakery stand on the property in Loveland, Colorado. These Terms & Conditions ("**Terms**") govern your access to and use of the Site.

Preamble and Acceptance. By accessing or using the Site, you agree to be bound by these Terms and the Company's Privacy Policy ("**Privacy Policy**"). If a checkbox is presented on the Site's contact form, checking the box and submitting the form also affirms your agreement to these Terms and the Privacy Policy. If you do not agree, do not use the Site.

12. About the Business and the Site. The Company is an allergy-friendly cottage food

bakery located in Loveland, Colorado, producing a small menu of baked goods in a home

kitchen and selling directly to the end user from a bakery stand on the property. The Site

provides general information about the Company and ingredients used in recipes and offers a contact form to inquire about catering or larger orders. Content on the Site is informational only and is not an online offer that can be accepted. Orders, availability, ingredients, and pricing are confirmed offline and are subject to change.

13. Allergy, Ingredient, and Health Information Disclaimer. "Allergy-friendly"

reflects the Company's efforts to avoid certain allergens; however, products are not guaranteed to be allergen-free, and cross-contact may occur. Ingredients listed on the Site are for general information and may change. The definitive ingredient information is on the product label at the time of sale or as provided directly by the Company during order confirmation. The Site does not provide medical or nutritional advice. Individuals with allergies or dietary restrictions should consult a

qualified professional and contact the Company directly before purchasing or consuming products.

14. Cottage Food Notices (Colorado-Specific Context). Products are produced in a

home kitchen under Colorado cottage food laws, are not inspected or licensed in the same manner as commercial kitchens, and are sold directly to the end consumer. Typical label disclosures required under Colorado law will be provided at sale as applicable, and those labels or notices control over any general information on the Site. Products are for end-user consumption only and are not for resale. No shipping is offered via the Site.

15. Permitted Use of the Site and Intellectual Property. All content on the Site,

including text, images, logos, ingredient lists, recipe descriptions, and design ("**Site Content**"),

is owned by the Company or its licensors and is protected by applicable intellectual property

laws. The Company grants you a limited, revocable, nonexclusive, nontransferable license to

address, and a message describing what you would like to order or ask about. You must not submit unlawful, infringing, misleading, or inappropriate content, and you should not send sensitive information (including medical or allergy information) via the form or by email. By submitting a message, you authorize the Company to use the submission to respond to your inquiry, plan potential orders, and communicate with you about availability and logistics. The Company may, in its discretion, decline to respond to or proceed with any inquiry.

misappropriation of any intellectual property, privacy, or other rights of any person or entity.

20. Prohibited Conduct and Site Security. You agree not to:

(a) Interfere with or disrupt the Site, the hosting environment, or related networks or systems.

(b) Reverse engineer, scrape, or use automated means (including bots, spiders, or crawlers) to access or collect data from the Site without the Company's prior

written permission.

(c) Upload, post, or transmit any malicious code, including viruses, worms, or Trojan

horses.

(d) Attempt to gain unauthorized access to the Site, servers, or related systems, or to user

21. Governing Law; Venue. These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of

Colorado, without regard to its conflict-of-law principles. You consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the state or federal courts located in Larimer County, Colorado, and you waive any objection to such courts based on inconvenient forum or lack of jurisdiction.

22. Changes to the Site and to These Terms. The Company may update or modify the Site and these Terms at any time in its discretion. Changes are effective when posted on the Site unless a later date is stated. Your continued use of the Site after changes become effective constitutes your acceptance of the updated Terms. Please review these Terms periodically.
